# Why **Legalisation** Matters

Your **East Bridge University (EBU)** qualification is designed for global learners and international careers.

However, when using your degree **outside France**, many employers, universities, and authorities require **official proof of authenticity**.

**Legalisation and Apostille procedures** serve this purpose.

They confirm that your academic document:

- Was genuinely issued by East Bridge University
- Bears valid signatures and seals
- Originates from a legally incorporated institution in Paris, France

This process **verifies authenticity**, not academic content or equivalency.

# The Hague **Apostille** Convention (1961)

The Hague Apostille Convention is an international treaty that simplifies document legalisation between member countries.

It includes **120+ countries**, such as:

- Most European nations
- United States
- United Kingdom
- Canada
- Mexico
- Saudi Arabia
- Philippines
- Many others

Since France is a Hague Convention signatory, EBU academic documents can be apostilled directly in France.

## **What this means for you:**

If your destination country is a **Hague Convention member**, your EBU degree requires **only a French Apostille** – no embassy legalisation is needed.

# How EBU Supports You

## For Hague Apostille Convention Countries

*(e.g. USA, UK, Canada, EU nations, Saudi Arabia, Oman, Mexico, Philippines)*

### EBU assists with:

- ✓ **French Apostille or e-Apostille** on your academic documents
- ✓ **Sworn translations**, if required by the destination country

*Once apostilled, your document is recognised across all Hague Convention countries without further embassy legalisation.*

## For Non-Hague Countries

*(e.g. Kuwait, Qatar, some African and Asian jurisdictions)*

### These countries require Embassy / Consular Legalisation, which may include:

- ✓ French Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MEAE) Legalisation
- ✓ Legalisation by the destination country's Embassy or Consulate in Paris
- ✓ Final Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) attestation in the destination country

EBU provides **step-by-step** guidance through this process.





# Important to Remember



✓ **Apostille and Legalisation confirm authenticity only**

(They do not determine academic equivalency or recognition.)

**Requirements may vary based on:**

- ✓ *Country*
  - ✓ *Purpose (employment, further study, immigration)*
  - ✓ *Sector or employer*
- ✓ Some authorities may request **additional verification or evaluation** independently.
