Course evaluation; Distribution of Certificate of Attendance; Excursion and other external cultural activities.

Motivate your Students with Creative Teaching Strategies

Course Description:

This course aims to integrate creative thinking and problem-solving in lesson planning developing student-centered activities to foster student engagement and motivation. DAY - 3 : Integrating thinking strategies

Integrating visual/artful thinking strategies in your lesson plan ; Fostering problem-solving skills ; Active learning through ICT(hands-on activity).

DAY - 4 : Enhancing through new methods

Vocabulary games; Grammar practice in speaking and writing ; Using real-life objects.

DAY - 5 : Get creative

Mind Mapping; Promoting creative thinking ; What's your twist? Implementing what you've learned.

DAY - 6 : Course closure & cultural activities

Course evaluation ; Distribution of Certificate of Attendance ; Excursion and other external cultural activities.

Digital Tools and Techniques for Student Engagement

Course Description:

In the era of digital transformation, the education sector has also undergone several shifts that require educators to develop a keen understanding of the technological resources, edTech apps, and AI tools. This course focuses on enhancing classroom management, optimizing engagement through digital tools, and leveraging platforms like Google Classroom for better learning outcomes. Participants will gain hands-on experience in creating impactful lesson plans and presentations and creating digital tests and quizzes.

Learning outcomes:

- Gain proficiency in Classroom Management Systems like Google Classroom
- Learn to design and deliver presentations, videos, and lesson plans
- Familiarise with tools for crafting interactive lessons using interactive boards and digital tools
- Formulate digital tests, and quizzes, and acquire tools to gather feedback
- Adapt to interactive teaching methods using tablets and computers

Tentative Schedule

DAY - 2 : Designing interactive lessons

Design presentations, videos, and interactive lesson plans ; Digital tools for interactive teaching.

DAY - 3 : Interactive boards, tests, and quizzes

Role of interactive boards in modern education ; Designing digital tests and quizzes.

DAY - 4 : Gathering feedback from students

Learn tools to gather real-time student feedback; Create lessons using digital tools.

DAY - 5 : Remote teaching and interactive online classroom

Explore the difficulties of remote and online teaching; Gamified elements and strategies for an interactive online classroom.

DAY - 6 : Course closure & cultural activities

Course evaluation; Distribution of Certificate of Attendance; Excursion and other external cultural activities.

ICT Basic Tools for Gamification and 21st Century Skills

Course Description:

The 21st-century educational landscape demands greater technological integration with traditional learning methods. It has become imperative for educators to integrate AI tools to foster the development of vital skills in students, such as critical thinking, collaboration, and creativity. This program will equip educators with the essential skills to navigate EdTech Apps and AI tools. Participants will learn to integrate technology into lesson plans and discover the power of gamification. Practical experiences include hands-on sessions on Kahoot! for quizzes, Padlet for collaborative projects, and Canva to create engaging materials for the class.

Learning outcomes:

- Learn the effective use of ICT tools
- Understand the principles of gamification
- Create interactive lessons that foster critical thinking, collaboration, creativity
- Overcome common challenges in the integration of classroom technology
- Learn the best practices in ICT tools usage and gamification in learning

DAY - 3 : Online quizzes and games

Kahoot ; Mentimeter ; Jeopardy ; Plikers.

DAY - 4 : ICT tools to foster collaboration

Padlet ; Google Drive ; Classroom management tools ; Trello.

DAY - 5 : ICT tools to foster creativity and critical thinking

Canva; Genially; TedEd; Reflection and questions; Evaluation of 21st-century skills; Professional Development; Workshop Conclusion, Certification, and Future Steps.

DAY - 6 : Course closure and cultural activities

Course evaluation; Distribution of Certificate of Attendance; Excursion and other external cultural activities.

Facing Diversity: Intercultural Classroom Management

Course Description:

Working in multicultural educational settings demands innovative teaching and learning approaches that often differ from traditional classroom teaching. Through this course, participants will gain comprehensive knowledge of intercultural educational practices that meet the needs of culturally diverse students without interrupting the regular didactic flow. The course will address creating a syllabus for diverse students, overcoming language barriers, and promoting productive intercultural interactions.

Learning outcomes:

- Identify different learning approaches & choose the correct teaching strategies
- Choose suitable methods for different classes, contexts, and moments during the lesson
- Select teaching strategies with concrete, across-the-board objectives
- Acquire expertise related to intercultural communication
- Convert diversity from burden to opportunity

Tentative Schedule

Introduction to the course and school along with Icebreaker activities; Presentations and Warm-up games; Typical multicultural classroom management problems; Needs analysis and Classroom "Identikit"; Presentations of the participatory schools

DAY - 2 : Mindfulness and reflection

Active listening, empathy, mindfulness ; Inclusive school: what unites us and what divides us? Games and soft skills

DAY - 3 : Relation vs tolerance

A matter of identity: relation VS tolerance; Recognizing oneself and being recognized; The narrative construction of identity; Autobiographies.

DAY - 4 : Language for communication

Communicative needs; Language to establish relationships; Language to study; Language for full integration; Mixed ability classes: Methods of Differentiation and cooperative learning.

DAY - 5 : Inclusive school

Families and schools: strengthening relations; Building Inclusive Environments: from multicultural to intercultural classes.

DAY - 6 : Course closure and cultural activities

Course evaluation; Distribution of Certificate of Attendance; Excursion and other external cultural activities.
