Why Legalisation Matters

Your East Bridge University (EBU) degree opens doors worldwide — for jobs and further study. But before your qualification is accepted abroad, many countries require proof of authenticity.

That's where the Apostille and Legalisation process comes in. It confirms that your degree was officially issued and signed by EBU, a legally incorporated university in Paris, France.

The Hague Apostille Convention

The Hague Apostille Convention (1961) is an international treaty signed by over 120 countries, including most of Europe, the USA, Canada, Mexico, Saudi Arabia, and many others.

If your destination country is part of this Convention, your EBU degree only needs a French Apostille to be valid abroad. Once apostilled, your certificate is automatically recognised in all Convention countries without further embassy legalisation.

France is a member of the Hague Convention. This means EBU degrees can be directly apostilled in France through the Notaires de France Apostille Centres.







How EBU Supports You

Apostille Convention Countries

For countries like the USA, UK, Canada, EU nations, Saudi Arabia, Oman, Mexico, Philippines:

- EBU arranges the French Apostille on your degree.
- If required, a sworn translation is added into the local language.
- This apostille is sufficient proof of authenticity for all Hague Convention countries.



Non-Apostille Countries

Some countries (e.g., Kuwait, Qatar) are not part of the Hague Convention. For them, the process includes:

- French Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MEAE) Legalisation
- Destination Embassy/Consulate Legalisation in Paris
- Final MOFA Attestation in the destination country

Remember

- Apostille = authenticity of signatures and seals, not content or academic equivalency.
- EBU will guide you step by step, depending on where you plan to use your degree.
- Requirements may vary between countries and sectors (employment vs. further study).
